Parents and Students,

This letter is to inform you of changes that have been made to the Advanced Placement (AP) exam registration process. College Board, the company that administers AP exams, has moved the registration process to October. Previously, we have registered students for AP exams in March. College Board feels students will be more committed to their AP course if they register for the exam early in the school year. The AP exams will still be held in May. These dates are not flexible, if your student decides to take the AP exam they are committing to the test date.

I want to specifically address the change in cost structure of exam registration. The cost of the exams will remain the same, \$94 per exam or \$15 per exam if the student qualifies for free/reduced lunch. College Board will charge an additional \$40 fee to all students who register for the exam after the October 4th deadline. Additionally, College Board will charge a \$40 fee to any student who registers for an AP exam and then chooses not to take that exam.

I have included an AP Exam schedule and a registration form with this e-mail. Students who would like to register for the AP exam should hand in their completed form and payment to their counselor by Friday, October 4th. Please contact your child's AP teacher or counselor if you have questions about AP exams.
